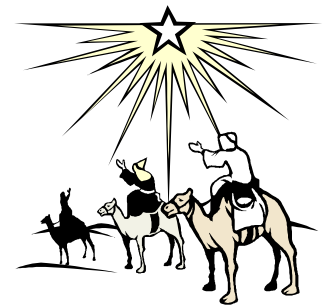

When Jesus was born in Bethlehem there were no doubt many babies born the same night named Jesus because it was a common name like John. Many people liked the name Jesus and named their boys with some variation of the name but there would be only ONE Christ Child. It must have been quite confusing for anyone to look for the Christ Child named Jesus unless they had proper information to make the positive identification. The angel appeared to the shepherds and the glory of the Lord shone round about them and they revered God and listened to the angel of the Lord. Their hearts had been prepared to receive instructions and there could now be no mistaken identity about the baby they were to find. I am quite sure many were looking for Him at the most famous places around since He was to be a king of deliverance for His people. No doubt many were counting the camels and donkeys in the parking lots to determine which famous spot would host such an honored guest. Some probably ventured inside to see how many would be showering him with gifts. Instead He was born in a lowly stable in the side of the hill among the cows, sheep and other animals. Here was the “Christ Child” much alone with Mary, His mother and Joseph, His step-father. What a disappointment it must have been to the local town’s people as they learned of our dear Savior’s birth?

The shepherds could have said, “Well this certainly is not Him because of the surroundings, the crowd is so small, you can barely see Him because of the dim lights and the smell is so bad here.”

Here is the identity key;

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a publick example, was minded to put her away privily. But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins. Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us. Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife: And knew her not till she had brought forth her first-born son: and he called his name

JESUS. Matthew 1:18-25

Only one child could fit this key to the true identity of the “Christ Child” because the angel of the Lord had declared it to the prophet and to Mary, the mother of Jesus and last but not least, the stepfather of Jesus, Joseph. Jesus was the adopted son of Joseph not his biological son and we must not forget this important fact. This begins the track of unmistakable identity of the “Christ Child” named Jesus. Now let’s look at the event with the shepherds who were in the fields doing their life work when the announcement came.

An angel announces it to the shepherds.

And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid. And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.

And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men. And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said one to another, Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known unto us. And they came with haste, and found Mary, and Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger. And when they had seen it, they made known abroad the saying which was told them concerning this child. And all they that heard it wondered at those things which were told them by the shepherds. But Mary kept all these things, and pondered them in her heart. And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them. Luke 2:8-20

The next part of the key to unmistakable identity was the garment in which they were to find the baby, swaddling clothes (strips of cloth usually wrapped around the newborn) which could not have been much of a sign to the shepherds. The truth is there were several signs and they all had to match such as the clothes and the manger combination. The most important thing it seems to me was that He was disconnected from natural man by the "Virgin Birth" and without that there would be no "Christ Child". This would separate Him from any other Jesus born into the world that night and for all eternity. This is one of the most fundamental

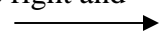
doctrines of the Bible and it is probably the most hated by the world. The shepherds came with haste because they were told by an angel and they believed the report and when they came they found Jesus wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. You see, it was a divine revelation to them while others scoffed and wondered at the things told them by the shepherds because they had no contact with the angelic beings nor were they excited and happy about the things they heard. If the shepherds had only looked for a baby Jesus wrapped in swaddling clothes and born in Bethlehem then they could have been victims of mistaken identity. They were very meticulous in their investigation and everything had to match up for it to be the "Christ Child" born of a virgin.

In life so many things seem so easy until we examine the whole matter and then we find many are spiritually discerned and logic is ruled out by faith and a dependence on the Holy Ghost for guidance. If Jesus were born today men would just go online and do a "Google Search" or go to some chat room and allow someone in a dark dungeon someplace to help them ascertain where the "Christ Child" is to be born and then use their GPS to find Him. While this seems quite ridiculous it is about the equivalent of what many are doing in their search for spiritual guidance. What has happened is that many wait for their pastor, Sunday School Teacher or General Overseer to point the way out for them so they will not have to read the Bible or study for themselves. Some even go to the help lines on

the internet to get spiritual guidance from people they will never see. They put great faith into whatever comes out of this that they can agree on. If you really want an experience go on line and ask the question, what are we to do about "Feet Washing" since Christ said for us to do it? One that is even better, what is fornication and adultery? The answers will depend on how many answer you back and then you just pick your favorite and make it your belief. An old man was asked by a young lad one day, "Sir why do you always sit on your porch and read your Bible?" To this the old man replied, "Someone told me this is God's Word and I want to know what He said." We must return to reading the Bible and asking God to give us divine revelation or we will go the way of the world church and believe nothing except the parts we agree with, leaving us with nothing but a self-service faith. The Bible tells us that we can believe a lie and be damned.

And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness. 2 Thessalonians 2:10-12

In this light let us now look at the second half of the title of this message, "...Many Churches, ONE CHURCH OF GOD." Many will say, "The Church of God of NC believes they are the only one right and



and the only one going to Heaven” but nothing could be farther from the truth. There is ONE Church, just as there is ONE Spirit, ONE God, ONE faith etc. She is exclusive and is owned and operated by Jesus after He purchased Her on Calvary with His blood. There are several biblical identifiers to this Body of Christ that I am attempting to identify here. It must be clearly understood that the Church and the Kingdom are not the same but are separate entities in the Holy Scriptures. The kingdom comes to the individual in the new birth but the Church isn’t entered that way, it is entered by covenant, much like the marriage covenant. It is the Lord who places you into the “Body of Christ” not the minister because if it were left up to the minister there could be mistaken identity. He could place an unregenerate person into the Church but Christ never will.

The first ingredient to identify His Church is LOVE, not as the world loves but as Christ loves without condition. It must be possessed not just professed and it will not involve the tearing apart of each other in order to elevate one above another. It will reach out to those who are unsaved and unlovable, not easily entreated and may not fit our molds so well. His Church must be searching for those who are lost on every continent and island of the sea with more than just handouts of money and clothing etc. Our reach must be with the precious Word of God and the promise of deliverance from sin rather than saved in their sins. It must be a message of not only Christ on the cross but about a

resurrected Christ with healing of both soul and body. Our message to the world must be the FULL GOSPEL which includes the message of His Church. It must be once again a message of perfection prior to the coming of the Lord to receive Her.

A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another. John 13:34-35

Every church is of man except the CHURCH OF GOD! Men have been very busy since the coming of Jesus in order to establish a different door, an easier way, something that would be more attractive. The denomination system was created by the devil to deceive people and mock God and was begun on the side of the mountain just after Christ had organized His Church when His disciples found them working in His name even though they were not part of them and Jesus told them to leave them alone.

The world system still thinks it was done at Pentecost while the Bible is clear in Marks Gospel when and where it happened.

He chooses His twelve apostles:

And he goeth up into a mountain, and calleth unto him whom he would: and they came unto him. And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach, And to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out devils: And Simon he surnamed Peter; And

James the son of Zebedee, and John the brother of James; and he surnamed them Boanerges, which is, The sons of thunder: And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite, And Judas Iscariot, which also betrayed him: and they went into an house. And the multitude cometh together again, so that they could not so much as eat bread. And when his friends heard of it, they went out to lay hold on him: for they said, He is beside himself. Mark 3:13-21

Three thousand converts are baptized:

Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call. And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation. Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.

His apostles work miracles:

And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. And fear came upon every soul: and

many wonders and signs were done by the apostles. And all that believed were together, and had all things common; And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all men, as every man had need. And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved. Acts 2:37-47

NOTE: There are two very important points of doctrine here;

1. **The three thousand were added to something (The Church)**, you cannot add to something that doesn't exist so the Church had previously been organized by Christ on the Horns of Hittin as found in Mark 3:13.
2. **The Lord added to their number those that were being saved**, not the Apostles.

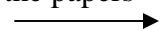
Ministers can no more add someone to the Church than they can make a man and a woman one flesh in marriage, their role is to perform the ceremony before God in both cases and it is the Lord that makes two one and one part of His Church. No man can place you in His Church and no man can take you out of His Church. The instructions to the Church is to break fellowship with those who error and will not hear the Church and be reconciled to one another, nowhere does it say we have the power to remove them

but we are obligated to break fellowship with them. Denominations continue the path of least resistance and they have painted the picture in so many ways you would think they would run out of ideas but no, they just keep reinventing the wheel. The way of truth is offensive to them and they excuse their behavior by saying, "Nobody's perfect." Jesus' way is offensive to them. Just imagine what the man thought that had his eyes anointed with mud? God's way is often simple, undesirable and even at times muddy but if we refuse it we will ultimately perish. Most of the evangelical churches at one time practiced "Washing the saint's feet" but they have since sanitized that part of the sacrament out of their conferences as unacceptable doctrine today. The Church which Jesus built and is building is just as undesirable to the world system as the Baby Jesus was in the midst of all those stinking animals. We have sanitized the stable scene and put the mother and Joseph in some pretty garments, cleaned the straw and placed Jesus in a manger very clean and pretty. The truth is that not many accepted this birth as the promised Messiah because it did not fit the pattern or understanding they had of the coming promised Messiah. Just imagine being a Jew and seeing such a mess as this was for a king to be born in?

People today can't find the "TRUE CHURCH" for many of the same reasons they could not locate Baby Jesus, the "CHRIST CHILD:

- The Holy Spirit is not leading them
- They have not found the markings of the TRUE CHURCH to be present
- They are looking for a PERFECT CHURCH
- They are looking for a LARGE NUMBER OF MEMBERS in it
- They are looking for the glamour and glitter of the world in it

His Church does exist on this earth today but it will not be found until the problems stated above have been properly dealt with by those in search of HER. Many tell us today they are IT and there is no other but upon careful examination the markings are not there. We must be His Church, His way and then the marks will identify the BODY and all will know we are THE CHURCH OF GOD (of prophecy) found in the Bible. Love will flow from one bosom to another as brothers and sisters in Christ, having the same care one for another. You will not ever find the Church to be perfect in your own eyes; only God will judge His Church perfect and when He does Jesus will come for Her. She will not stay in this corrupt world for long upon reaching the mark set for Her by God so don't waste your time looking for a PERFECT CHURCH. If She had reached perfection, we could not see it because of the lack of our own perfection. The fact that the world does not believe this message will not change the biblical truth contained in it. His Church will never be His because of the name on the lawn or the papers



found at the court house but because of the Christ like spirit found in its members who have bound themselves to Him by covenant to obey His Word in all things.

There are threescore queens, and fourscore concubines, and virgins without number. My dove, my undefiled is but one; she is the only one of her mother, she is the choice one of her that bare her. The daughters saw her, and blessed her; yea, the queens and the concubines, and they praised her. Who is she that looketh forth as the morning, fair as the moon, clear as the sun, and terrible as an army with banners? Song of Solomon 6:8-10

Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood. Acts 20:28

You must choose to work for God where you have a vision for the work and believe in your heart that it is right just as I have done but as for me I will work for no denomination but only for the ONE CHURCH found in the Bible, THE CHURCH OF GOD. On November 14, 2009, I was taken to University Hospital in Augusta, Georgia, where I underwent emergency surgery. They told me that my gall bladder was totally destroyed and had to be removed immediately. This came as no surprise because for a number of years I knew that there was some sort of problem in that general area. The day after the surgery, I did receive some unexpected news. They had done a biopsy of my liver and told me that I had cancer. Well that did come as a surprise, but I was calm and ready for any other news they might have. I have always believed in God's power to heal and I felt confident that He could do that for me and I believed that He would.

Over the next few month's I would experience some of the worst pain that I had ever known in my life. Seems as though it was endless and the brutal attacks from the enemy were hard, fast and also endless. I had lost a tremendous amount of weight but through my mid-section I was as big as two people. Because of the medications that were prescribed, my appetite was gone. Soon my hair began to fall out and my skin began to turn yellow from the disease. My energy level was zero and I was so very tired all the time. Still I hung right on to Jesus and trusted His Word. There were times when I could not even pray, but Jesus would come to me and speak His Word into my spirit. There were times when all I could do would be to reach over to my nightstand and lay The Bible on myself and rebuke the devil. I wore a prayer cloth that had been anointed and prayed over at our National Convention the year before, and I would speak the healing scriptures to my body, commanding it to get in line with God's Word.

Weeks and then month's went by and although I did not feel much relief from the disease, I would get an encouraging report from the specialist every time I went to him. I began to rely more and more on God as time went on and with His constant help I finally came to realize that He was healing me! No, it was not something that happened completely overnight, but praise God it did happen! I recall the Dr. becoming angry with me at one point because he felt that I was not taking the illness seriously. He saw me encouraged, in a good mood, and always cheerful when I would see him. This was not typical behavior for someone that was as sick as myself. I would always give God the glory whenever he would say that I was a little better.

Although many of you were faithful in praying for me daily, you did not know how gravely ill that I was. Now I want to thank all of you wonderful saints that kept me lifted up before The Lord. He heard and He answered! The last report that I received from my Dr. I was told that the liver was perfect and that I should keep on doing what I had been doing! So much for the liver transplant that I will never need thanks, to God! My sister Shirley Evans once asked the Dr. If he believed in miracles. He didn't really say but I feel he has given it some consideration at this point. How else would someone describe what God has done for me? Yes, there are wonderful doctor's and yes there are wonderful medications but there is only ONE whose stripes healed us over two thousand years ago!!!

Justification results from repentance and faith in Jesus Christ as our Lord and Saviour. The blood He shed on Calvary flows down and takes away your sins. No one has to tell you that you are saved, oh you will feel it in your soul, and you will know the moment He sets you free. Hallelujah! His blood just dripped down and covered you. Praise God forever! You are no longer separated from God, Jesus is the supreme sacrifice, His blood takes away our sins. The blood sacrifice of animals could not take away our sins. However, when we are covered in the blood of Jesus, all past sins are cast into the sea of forgetfulness, as far as the East is from the West and we are forgiven and free from sin and the punishment of sin, which is the second death. We will be spared from the wrath of God and have become joint heirs with Christ, Thank you Jesus! If you are born twice once by the womb and born again in Christ by the Spirit you only face death once and Christ will be there with you the moment you draw your last breath in this life. Genesis 1:1 *In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.*

Genesis 1:26 *And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.*

Children we must not lose God's favor by changing the things He has given His Church. God's design will lead His Church, not a counterfeit.

Isaiah 5:26 *And he will lift up an ensign to the nations from far, and will hiss unto them from the end of the earth: and, behold, they shall come with speed swiftly:*

What is hiss or hissing? When I find the words hiss or hissing in the Word it is because of sin and disobedience. He was angry. What does this scripture say? He will hiss unto the nations. Its time to listen as God calls

(hisses). His people must measure to His word, walk softly before Him, fear Him with a godly fear, come under His ensign.

Revelation 20:11-12 *And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.*

We are all going to stand before the Prince of Peace, King of Kings, Lord of Lords, Counselor, Wonderful, the Everlasting Father, our Saviour now. He then will be our judge. The All Power.□

Psalm 133:1-3

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments; As the dew of Hermon, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, even life for evermore.

The dew that descended on Herman in the north is the same as the dew that descended on Zion in the south. Herman's fell on the tribes of Asher, Ephraim, Manasseh, Zebulon and Issachar. Zion's dew fell on the tribe of Judah. They were all mutually dependent upon the sweet refreshing dew from heaven. O how sweet the flowing of the precious Holy Ghost when he finds us, as on the day of Pentecost, with one accord. Like the precious ointment running down Aaron's beard. Like the refreshing dew flowing down the mountains of God's nation, the sweet refreshing of God the Holy Spirit (see Acts 3:19).

Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;

Colossians 1:9-11. *For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;*

Paul, the apostle, record for us an outline of how to pray for others.

(1) Do not cease to pray every day. The least that can happen is that our life will be enriched by our daily communion with our Lord and Savior, but O what great and mighty miracles are wrought by the effectual fervent prayers of righteous people. James 5:16-18 *Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for*

another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

- (2) Pray that they may filled with the knowledge of His will, and with the wisdom and understanding to implement it. We know that it is His will that His church be ONE because He told us St. John 17:22-23 *And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.* In praying be yielded to the Holy Spirit within, letting Him take over in unknown tongues when He wills. None of us know how to pray perfectly, but His Holy Spirit dwelling in us is striving constantly to bring us closer to Christ's perfect will.
- (3) Pray that their walk (life) be pleasing to God. It should be our great pleasure to know our brother/sister in Christ is getting closer to him. III John 3-4 *For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth. I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.* Praying that their works will be good as they increase in their knowledge of God.
- (4) Pray for God to make them strong in His glorious power.
Pray first for your own leader/overseer of the

group you adhere to. Take him through the four steps of the outline above. Earnestly and fervently pray for God to bless him from each of the four perspectives in this outline.

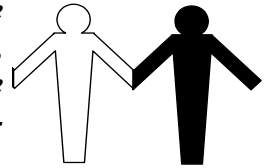
Pray for the leader/overseer of the other groups. Call each of their names out to God pleading for His grace and power to take each of them through these four parts of Paul's prayer. Pray for God to work in your heart until you want only God's best in their life and work.

After praying for the leadership pray for the membership. It is, when all is said and done, the people of our local churches that carry the load of the work. O pray until the white hot love is supplied by each joint to join and compact us until we are all one in Him. Ephesians 4:16 *From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.* I must supply the glue that sticks me to you. You must supply the glue that sticks you to me. It is the intense power of Christ's love in us that melts us together increasing and edifying the body we all love.

Remember the times when these divisions occurred. Remember the harsh words that were spoken.

Remember the intense disappointment in the choices beloved fellow labors made. Remember the hurt that tore our hearts, when Satan was wreaking havoc on our unity. Pray much for those we feel used or abused us during those times. Matthew 5:44-46 *But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust. For if ye love them which love you, what reward have ye? do not even the publicans the same?* Call their names out to God taking them in your prayer through the four steps of Paul's prayer for the saints at Colosse. Pray earnestly for God's very best in their lives. Feel the love of God in you, reaching out in your prayer, desiring that they receive the very best of God's will for them.

Do not cease to pray daily for the unity of the Body of Christ. Ephesians 4:13 *Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:* □

A Vision of the Mission

Proverbs 29:19a *Where there is no vision, the people perish...*

Vision – To perceive mentally; to contemplate (look at with continued attention, to think fully or deeply about); a divine revelation or oracle (utterance of God). It goes far beyond what is seen by the natural eye. Mission- an official assignment.

Down through time, it has taken men and women of God with a clear, strong vision to get us to where we are today. I'm sure you could name many who have been an inspiration and a great help to you, but it can't stop now! Somebody today must carry that same faith in God with a **clear, strong** vision to those after us. I want to be a part of God's last days' program; how about you?

There are many wonderful examples throughout the word of God that could be examined here today, but space would not permit. However, there is one from the New Testament that will be the focus today- one who truly had a vision of his mission and that one is John the Baptist. His assignment or mission is found recorded by the prophet Isaiah many years before John would come on the scene. Isaiah 40:3 *The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness. Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.* There is a lot in this passage, but let's examine some of the key words. As these meanings are presented, think about them on spiritual terms as well: crieth-to proclaim publicly and loudly. What this voice was to proclaim would not be in secret nor to a few; wilderness- wasteland, barren, solitary, lonesome ; prepare- make ready for some purpose or event; way- a road (as trodden), a journey, a course of life or mode of action; straight-to be right, to steer; desert- a dry, barren region that can support little or no vegetation; highway- a main **public** road, especially one **connecting** towns and cities.

John was born to cry out in the wilderness that the Christ is come. As a highway that connects one city to another, he was to connect them to Christ! He never said he was the Christ, but rather pointed them to Christ – preparing their hearts to receive Christ and

then the blessings which would follow, both in this life and the one at the end of the journey. **There is a right way!** (then and now) You don't have to dwell in spiritual barrenness any longer. You don't have to dwell in the hot, dry desert anymore. There is one which offers cool, refreshing water which satisfies the thirsty soul! John knew what his mission was because he had a clear, strong vision of it. Oh, that The Church of God today would catch the spirit that John had to fulfill his mission.

John's Parents- Luke chapter 1 tells about an older couple who *were both righteous before God, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless* according to verse 6. Their names were Zacharias and Elizabeth. The Bible says that Elizabeth was barren. They wanted a child, so they prayed to God about it. Aren't you glad that we can go to God in prayer about anything! As Zacharias executed his duties of the priest's office before God, an angel spoke to him. Luke 1: 13-17 *But the angel said unto him, Fear not Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elizabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John. And thou shalt have joy and gladness; and many shall rejoice at his birth. For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb. And many of the children of Israel shall he turn to the Lord their God. And he (John) shall go before him (Jesus) in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.* Now the scripture tells us that both Elizabeth and Zacharias were filled with the Holy Ghost- Elizabeth before John was born and Zacharias after his birth. In the scriptures just cited, the angel had revealed to Zacharias the mission of his son, and when John was born and Zacharias was filled with the Holy Ghost, he began to prophesy about that mission (Luke 1: 76-80)

So John's parents were well informed concerning this mission and no doubt there was much discussion among the three of them as John *grew and waxed strong in spirit*. But John would have to know it for himself. There was a set time for his appearing.

The scriptures record nothing about his childhood except that he would be filled with the Holy Ghost from his mother's womb. I believe that John was driven by the spirit into the wilderness when he was of age. There he was alone with God – studying and meditating on the scriptures and his mission. Through the years, it became clearer and stronger. Let's revisit something the angel said to Zacharias in Luke 1:17a *And he (John) shall go before him (Christ) in the spirit and power of Elias...* What kind of spirit did Elijah possess? Elijah was a man of God and people knew that he was. He communed with the Lord. He listened to the voice of God. He went where God told him to go and he did what God told him to do. The spirit of obedience was on him! He feared God and not man. He didn't care what man thought about him, he let God work through him to accomplish His (God's) will. And so John would possess that same spirit. He dwelt in the wilderness. He did not look like everybody else-his clothes were of camels' hair. He did not act like everybody else – he ate grasshoppers and wild honey. While others attended parties and social gatherings, he was dwelling in the desert, but filled with the Holy Ghost and seeking God daily. You see, Isaiah did not mention anything in his prophecy about baptizing, but that was part of his mission. The Holy Ghost knew that and at some point gave him that direction. Luke 3: 2-4 *Annas and Caiaphas being the high priests, the word of God came unto John the son of Zacharias in the wilderness. And he came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins; As it is written in the book of the words of Esaias the prophet, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.* The word of the Lord never fails!

John 1:19-23 tells that the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask John just who he was. He told them with confidence that he was not the Christ, but pointed them to the one who would come after him. Verse 29-34 of that same chapter reads, *The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which*

taketh away the sin of the world. (He was connecting them to Jesus and note that he had not yet met Jesus) *This is he of whom I said, After me cometh a man which is preferred before me: for he was before me. And I knew him not: but that he should be made manifest to Israel, therefore am I come baptizing with water. And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him. And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, (see verse 6) the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost. And I saw and bare record that this is the son of God.* The Holy Ghost revealed unto him how he would recognize the Christ when he saw him. So John remained strong and he continued on in the commandments and doctrines of Christ, even though it would cost him his life!

Matthew 11:2 says *Now when John had heard in the prison the works of Christ, he sent two of his disciples.* Prison! Why was he in prison! The account is recorded in Matthew 14: 1-12. He was there for telling Herod that it was not lawful for him to have his brother Philip's wife. Is that not the same doctrine that we preach today! Is it any better accepted today than then? **No!** But John **knew** and **believed** and **stood up** for what was right no matter what! God is looking today for those who **know** and **still believe** and **will take a stand** for what is right – for **all** that is recorded in the word of God. Let's continue. John had heard the works of Christ while he was in prison and sent two of his disciples. Matthew 11:3 *And said unto him, Art thou he that should come, or do we look for another?* I've heard some say that John was only human and that he began to doubt. I do not believe that at all. Yes, he was human, but I do not believe that he began to doubt for a moment! I believe that he did that for his disciples benefit. His vision was still clear and strong! And Jesus knew it too! He sent word back to John in verse 4-6 *Jesus answered and said unto them, **Go and shew John again those things which ye do hear and see: The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them. And blessed is he, whosoever shall not be offended in me.*** John was not offended in Christ. Verse 7 says, *And as they departed, Jesus began to say* →

unto the multitude concerning John, What went ye out into the wilderness to see? A reed shaken with the wind? Remember, John dwelt in the wilderness, but **multitudes** left the towns and cities and went out into the wilderness to where he was to see him. Here Jesus asked them a question, What did you go out to see – a reed shaken with the wind? What is a reed anyway? It is tall grass which sways this way and that according to the direction the wind blows against it. It is in no wise stable, but John was **not** as a reed or as James 1:6 describes one who wavers *like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed*. No! He was just as stable as he had always been. Matthew 11:8-10 says *But what went ye out for to see? A man clothed in soft raiment? Behold, they that wear soft clothing are in kings' houses. But what went ye out for to see? A prophet? yea, I say unto you, and more than a prophet. For this is he, of whom it is written, Behold, I send my messenger before thy face, which shall prepare thy way before thee.* So if they wanted to see a man in soft clothes, they should have gone to the king's house. Remember, his clothes were of camels' hair. He did not care that he didn't look like everybody else – neither was his mind where others were. His mind was on his mission of which he had a clear, strong vision! And he did accomplish his mission because of that vision and because he really believed in what he was doing and in the one who sent him to do it!

That is exactly what is needed today. People of God with a clear, strong vision of their mission and who really believe in what they are doing and in the one who sent them to do it! Otherwise, it is only a form of godliness with merely going through the motion of

religion. It takes faith in God! II Corinthians 5:7 says *(For we walk by faith, not by sight:)* That is not by physical sight.

I'm sure everyone has at sometime or another looked through a telescope, microscope or a magnifying glass. These instruments bring the objects closer in view. Through them can be seen things which are unseen with the natural eye. If you looked at your hands under a microscope, you would be amazed at what you see that cannot be seen otherwise. Take out your telescope of faith today. We can have what God says we can have and we can do what God says we can do. A person can and many are living lives of purity in this sinful generation. People everywhere need the Lord. Let us, as John did, connect people to Christ. We can't save one soul or solve anybody's problems, but we know the one who can! Let them know there is a right way and those who walk in it will obtain blessings and victory right in the midst of toil and trouble. The Bible is full of examples, but time and space would not permit the expounding of Moses, Noah, Joshua, David, Elisha, Stephen or even Paul, but I want to close with the followings passages found in Hebrews 12:2-3 *Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.* Consider him (Christ). What if he had not carried out his mission.

Let us not fail; but rather pray – God make us a people with that clear, strong vision as John and let us be about your business with that same fervency and zeal. God Bless You. □

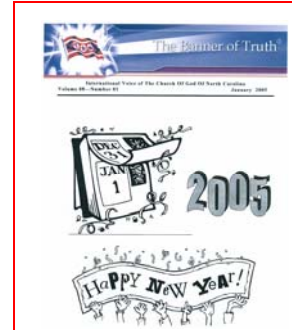

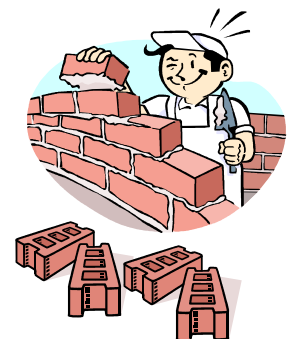
